1. **Prosecco, Vetricano (Italy) 11.5% alc** £19.95
An attractive biscuity nose leads onto a bright fruity palate with hints of pears and melon. An excellent aperitif. (*Taste Guide 1*)
2. **PROSECCO FRIZZANTE, TREVISO, Borgo Frare (Italy) 10.5% alc - 200ml Single Serve** £6.50
A gently sparkling wine with lovely soft peachy fruit, the palate is lovely and juicy with great balance and character. A great aperitif. (*Taste Guide 1*)
3. **TANNERS BRUT EXTRA RÉSERVE CHAMPAGNE (France) 12% alc** £44.67
A finely structured, fruit-driven style with an impression of white flowers, fleshy stone fruits and toast. (*Taste Guide 2*)
4. **VEUVE CLICQUOT YELLOW LABEL BRUT (France) 12% alc** £52.50
A rich, dry Champagne from this famous Reims house, blended from a high proportion of Pinot grapes and aged for a mature, rounded character. (*Taste Guide 1*)

An easy to drink quaffer, medium-sweet with a bundle of soft fruit. (Taste Guide 4) | £15.89

| 6. | WIDE RIVER CHENIN BLANC, Robertson (South Africa) 12.5% alc
Clean and bright Chenin Blanc, peppery and aromatic, with tropical fruit flavours of ripe fig and melon backed up with crisp, refreshing acidity. (Taste Guide 3) | £15.53

| 7. | LADERA VERDE SAUVIGNON, Valle Central (Chile) 12% alc
A very crisp, floral bouquet, typical of the Sauvignon grape, followed by a fresh grassy-gooseberry palate, dry but not austere. (Taste Guide 2) | £15.92

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| 9. | WIDE RIVER SHIRAZ, Robertson (South Africa) 14% alc
Deliciously plummy with a hint of spiciness, and plenty of meaty depth. (Taste Guide D) | £15.53

| 10. | LADERA VERDE MERLOT, Valle Central (Chile) 12.5% alc
Ripe juicy plummy Merlot fruit with good balance and length. (Taste Guide C) | £15.92

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| 12. | PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ, Provincia di Pavia, Ca'Solare (Italy) 12% alc
A copper pink rosé from northern Italy's Pavia region with gentle fragrant summer fruits on the nose and delicate strawberry fruit on the palate. Fruitily off-dry. (<i>Taste Guide 3</i>) | £16.98

| 13. | CALIFORNIA CREEK ZINFANDEL ROSÉ, California (USA) 10.5% alc
Light-bodied and medium-sweet, with aromatic sweet berry fruit, fleshy peach and juicy watermelon flavours. (<i>Taste Guide 5</i>) | £17.71

| 14. | CHÂTEAU DU GALOUPET, CRU CLASSÉ ROSÉ, Côtes de Provence (France) 13% alc
The nose is floral with hints of lychees, the palate more pronounced with great flavours of cherries and raspberries. The finish is elegant and fruity. (<i>Taste Guide 1</i>) | £27.37 |

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| 15. | LAS PAMPAS CHENIN/TORRONTÉS, Mendoza (Argentina) 13% alc
Light-bodied, crisp and floral, with a succulent, soft, round and tropical fruit core. (<i>Taste Guide 2</i>) | £15.86 |
| 16. | SAUVIGNON BLANC, Marlborough (New Zealand) 13.5% alc
Classic Kiwi Sauvignon, fresh, crisp, full of gooseberry and nettle fruit with great poise and elegance. (<i>Taste Guide 2</i>) | £23.32 |
| 17. | SUNNYCLIFF CHARDONNAY, Victoria (Australia) 14% alc
This wine has sheer drinkability, everything is well balanced so one glass is not enough! (<i>Taste Guide 2</i>) | £18.69 |
| 18. | RIOJA VEGA VIURA BLANCO, Rioja (Spain) 12.5% alc
A light fragrant Rioja made from the Viura grape variety. Youthful fruity citrus flavours with hints of herbs on the finish, this is un-oaked and juicy. (<i>Taste Guide 1</i>) | £17.59 |
| 19. | CHABLIS, Les Valery (France) 12% alc
This is textbook Chablis from one of the area's most successful producers. It has green-tinged hues, an elegant slightly steely quality with aromas and flavours of freshly baked brioche. (<i>Taste Guide 1</i>) | £34.90 |

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| 20. | <p>LAS PAMPAS MALBEC, Mendoza (Argentina) 13.5% alc
 A rich, full red with lovely damson and plum fruits. Soft tannins with a subtle hint of underlying oak. <i>(Taste Guide D)</i></p> | £16.81 |
| 21. | <p>CHÂTEAU CHASSANTOUR, Beaujolais- Villages Lantignié, M Perroud (France) 13% alc
 From a superbly situated vineyard on slopes looking down to Régnié, this is a light, flowery wine with delicate gamay fruit. <i>(Taste Guide B)</i></p> | £21.96 |
| 22. | <p>FREEDOM CROSS PINOTAGE, Coastal Region (South Africa) 14% alc
 The product of a crossing of Pinot Noir and Cinsault, Pinotage is South Africa's unique grape. This example is softly styled with intense blackberry fruit and mocha coffee notes. <i>(Taste Guide C)</i></p> | £17.52 |
| 23. | <p>PATO TORRENTE CABERNET SAUVIGNON, Valle Central (Chile) 13.5% alc
 Perfect New World Cabernet, with juicy blackcurrant fruit and a chocolatey palate with hints of plums. <i>(Taste Guide C)</i></p> | £17.63 |
| 24. | <p>SUNNYCLIFF SHIRAZ, Victoria (Australia) 13.5% alc
 Well made and easy going this has plenty of juicy black berry fruit flavours and very little tannin. <i>(Taste Guide C)</i></p> | £19.93 |
| 25. | <p>LOS COCHES PINOT NOIR, Valle Central (Chile) 13% alc
 Packed full of fresh red fruit character, this is classic New World Pinot from Chile. Good weight, plenty of ripe fruit and length and not at all jammy. <i>(Taste Guide B)</i></p> | £18.16 |
| 26. | <p>SAINT-EMILION, Jean-Pierre Moueix (France) 13% alc
 Libourne-based négociants J-P Moueix are specialists in the wines of that region and their Merlot based Saint-Emilion, soft and plummy, is one of the very best available. This is superb value so don't be put off by the lack of a château name.
